• Exams will be performed at the livestock handling facility at the Southern Piedmont AREC. Directions from US 460 (signs will be displayed):

- 1 Turn left onto SR 636 from Cox Rd (0.8 mi S from US 460) - 0.7 mi
- 2 Turn right onto MRTC Rd - 0.3 mi
- 3 Turn right into the grazing area (double gates) - 0.4 mi
- 4 Arrive at the livestock handling facility
